**OPEN CLASS** – For boys and girls at least 9 years old and under 18 years old on the day of the show, and who have won three (3) first place in a Novice Class at a licensed or member show, with competition present in the Novice Class.

**MASTER CLASS** - This class will be for boys and girls who are at least 9 years old and under 18 years old on the day of the show, and who have won the ten (10) first place wins in an Open Class with competition to be eligible to enter the Limited Class Competition. The calendar for this class will consistent with eligibility dates for the AKC Eukanuba National Championship.
