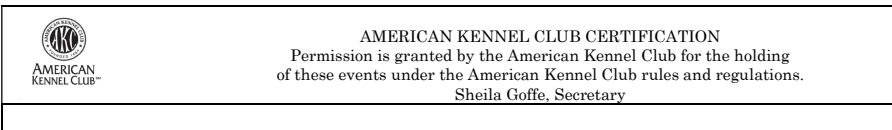

OFFERED AT SATURDAY AM and SUNDAY AM & PM SHOWS

**NOVICE CLASS** – For boys and girls at least 9 years old and under 18 years old on the day of the show and who, at the time entries close, have not won three (3) first place awards with competition present, in a Novice Class at a licensed or member show.

**OPEN CLASS** – For boys and girls at least 9 years old and under 18 years old on the day of the show, and who have won three (3) first place in a Novice Class at a licensed or member show, with competition present in the Novice Class.

**MASTER CLASS** - This class will be for boys and girls who are at least 9 years old and under 18 years old on the day of the show, and who have won the ten (10) first place wins in an Open Class with competition to be eligible to enter the Limited Class Competition. The calendar for this class will consistent with eligibility dates for the AKC Eukanuba National Championship. All Juniors meeting the criteria for this class are required to enter the Master Class and may change their entry the day of the show if entries have already closed. Once the eligibility time frame for that year has passed all participants return to the Open Class to compete for the following year.

The following categories of dogs may be entered and shown in Best of Breed competition; Dogs that are Champions of Record and dogs which according to their owners records, have completed the requirements of a championship, but whose championships are unconfirmed. The showing of unconfirmed Champions in Best of Breed competition is limited to a period of 90 days from the date of the show where the dog completed the requirements for the championship.
3. (Dog Show Class) Consult the classification in this premium list. If the dog show class in which you are entering your dog is divided, then, in addition to designating the class, specify the particular division of the class in which you are entering your dog i.e., age division, color division, weight division.
4. A dog must be entered in the name of the person who actually owned it at the time entries for a show closed. If a registered dog has been acquired by a new owner, it must be entered in the name of its new owner in any show for which entries closed after the date of acquirement, regardless of whether the new owner has received the registration certificate indicating that the dog is recorded in his name. **All dogs present** must be on a leash or confined to their crates except when being judged or when in an exercise pen. Place all trash in provided cans or plastic bags.

**Prizes and trophies** will be awarded in the ring to the person showing the dog. Claims for prizes and trophies must be made in the ring before the judging of that breed is over, and the show giving club disclaims any liability for prizes and trophies. None will be mailed.

**Entries close at 6:00pm, Wednesday, April 22, 2026**, at the address of the Show Secretary, after which time entries cannot be accepted, cancelled or substituted. Telephone and unsigned entries cannot be accepted. Entries not on official AKC entry forms are not acceptable. Entries received without fees will not be accepted.
